## Registration and Payment

Complete the application within this brochure and return it to the Municipal Athletic Complex (MAC) with the Registration fee of (Single Session) or (Multiple Session). Registrations will be taken until classes are filled. If room permits, skaters may start at anytime throughout any session.

The (Single Session) Registration fee is a one time fee of \$65.00 to be paid in FULL upon registration which covers related program expenses. This rate entitles the skater to skate in only one of the multiple sessions.

The (Multiple Session) Registration fee requires payments of \$60.00 upon registration and subsequent payments of \$60.00 to be paid by the first day of each session.

*Please Note: If you are undecided if your son/daughter will skate multiple sessions, please sign up for the Single Session. If later, you decide to sign up for other sessions, we will change your registration and you will be entitled to the Multiple Session rate.*

## EQUIPMENT

Skaters are to wear the following equipment:

- ◆ Helmet with a Full Face Shield
- ◆ Properly fitted ice skates
- ◆ Knee pads, Elbow pads
- ◆ Jersey or Sweatshirt
- ◆ Hockey gloves or mittens
- ◆ Breezers or sweatpants

Each player is encouraged to have his/her own hockey stick. Child size sticks are available at local sporting goods outlets.  
(Sticks will be cut to length on the 1st day of skating if needed)  
Skate Rental is available for \$3 per day.

## About the Program

The Municipal Athletic Complex (MAC) is once again proud to offer our 2009– 2010:

### “K & Pre-K” Hockey program.

The “K & Pre-K” Hockey Program has been developed to introduce youngsters, ages 4 - 6, to the sport of hockey and the skills of skating. It may also serve to augment area Youth Hockey Associations Mini Mite and/or Learn to Skate Basics Programs.

In a warm, friendly, yet challenging setting, the program will entertain and focus the attention of every youngster who will quickly begin to acquire the skills required to progress in the sport of hockey.

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE

Boys / Girls 4 - 6 years of age and have an interest in skating and the sport of hockey are eligible. Skaters are encouraged to remain in the program for as long as possible prior to starting 1st grade. As each child is unique, only the parent will be able to assess when their child has the independence and physical development to enroll. However, we have had tremendous success with children beginning in the program at age 4 and continuing to age 6.

\*Due to the Thanksgiving Holiday, there is No skating on Friday, November 25. There will also be No skating on Good Friday, April 6th.

\*\* The Municipal Athletic Complex’s ambient temperature is 50 degrees. Do not over-dress your skater for it will restrict movement. Skating is a strenuous sport. Even 4, 5 & 6 year olds will work up a sweat. \*\*
